



# ClomiGen (Clomiphene Tablets)

**50 mg/each**

**Oral Tablets**

## FORMULA

Each film coated tablet contains: Clomiphene citrate (50 mg), Excipients (q.s.)

## DOSAGE AND USE

- Usual Adult Dose for Ovulation Induction: 50 mg orally once a day for 5 days. Therapy should be initiated on or near the 5th day of the menstrual cycle, but may be started at any time in patients without recent uterine bleeding.
- Usual Adult Dose for Lactation Suppression: 50 to 100 mg orally once a day for 5 days. Generally, one course of therapy is sufficient.
- Usual Adult Dose for Oligospermia: 25 to 100 mg orally once a day. Therapy is generally given over a period of several months.

## CHARACTERISTICS AND INDICATIONS

ClomiGen contains a medicine called clomiphene citrate. This belongs to a group of medicines called ovulation stimulants. It works by stimulating the release of eggs from the ovary (ovulation).

ClomiGen is used for some types of infertility, in women who are not ovulating properly.

## ADVERSE REACTIONS / CONTRAINDICATIONS

Before you take the medicine talk to your doctor about the risks of:

- Becoming pregnant with more than one child at the same time (multiple pregnancies)
- Pregnancies where the baby grows outside of the womb (ectopic)
- A possible increased risk of ovarian cancer
- Any pregnancy could lead to birth defects or miscarriage. This can happen even if you are not taking ClomiGen. You should talk to your doctor about the possible risks before you take ClomiGen.

Do not take this medicine and tell your doctor if:

- You are allergic (hypersensitive) to clomifene or any of the other ingredients of ClomiGen
- Signs of an allergic reaction include: a rash, swallowing or breathing problems, swelling of your lips, face, throat or tongue
- You have or ever had liver disease
- You have unusual menstrual bleeding where the cause is not known
- You have a type of cancer that is made worse by hormones
- You have a cyst on your ovary
- You are pregnant. You should have a test to make sure you are not pregnant before you take ClomiGen

Do not take this medicine if any of the above apply to you.

Take special care with ClomiGen Check with your doctor or pharmacist before taking your medicine if:

- You are having an early menopause or have been told you are infertile
- You have stopped having periods because you are underweight
- You have had fits or seizures in the past
- You have 'fibroids' in your womb
- You have 'polycystic' ovaries
- Your ovaries are swollen
- You have hypertriglyceridemia (an excess of fats in the blood) or a family history of hypertriglyceridemia.

**Pregnancy and breastfeeding:** Do not take this medicine if you are pregnant or think you may be pregnant. Talk to your doctor before taking this medicine if you are breastfeeding or planning to breastfeed. ClomiGen can lower the amount of milk produced.

**Driving and using machines:** You may notice problems with your eyesight such as blurred vision while taking this medicine. If this happens, do not drive or use any tools or machines.

This medicine contains lactose and sucrose, which are types of sugar. If you have been told by your doctor that you can not tolerate some sugars, talk to your doctor before taking ClomiGen.

## DRUG INTERACTIONS

Please tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking or have recently taken any other medicines. This includes medicines you buy with a prescription, including herbal medicines. This is because ClomiGen can affect the way some other medicines work. Also some medicines can affect the way ClomiGen works.

## PRECAUTIONS AND WARNINGS

This medicine should not be taken by children, adolescents, men or women who have already gone through the menopause (postmenopausal).

## OVERDOSE

In case of adverse effects withdraw use of the drug and immediately call your doctor or pharmacist. You are likely to get over-stimulation of your ovary.
